- Review City Ordinances on Trees
 Trees in the City Right Tree, Right Place | City of Worcester, MA
 (worcesterma.gov)

Commissioner Wobbe said she went on to the Worcester Ordinance on public trees and noticed that there is a section of the ordinance, which allows for the removal of public shade trees to provide parking off street parking spaces. The ordinance was written in 2006, and she wondered if parking spaces should be prioritized over public shade trees.

Assistant Commissioner explained that Worcester is a city with many areas that have small streets and full of 4-deckers in which case there could be 1 or 2 cars for each floor. He said in the winter it is a challenge to plow the small streets with vehicles everywhere, so the thought pattern when they created this ordinance was to try to balance in regard to, how to get cars off the street while still preserving trees. So, when this happens and a homeowner petitions a

tree removal for the purpose of putting in a driveway, they have to go through a tree hearing, and they have to pay not only for the removal of the tree but also for the replacement of a tree based on that trees DBH, other reasons are if the tree's roots are going into a sewer line or if roots are uprooting and lifting the sidewalk.

Commissioner Elton said that there is room for improvement on the ordinance language.

Further discussions were had regarding planting, funding, the process and the language of the ordinance.

Commissioner Wobbe made a motion to table to the new table section in the agenda. Second by Commissioner Elton. All were in favor. Motion was approved 4-0.

• Worcester Urban Forestry Research Summit Commissioner Winbourne said she wanted open up a discussion as a reminder of the goal for setting a summit. There were 2 goals: One was to focus on educating people about caring for trees, and Two was more focused on bringing together area experts to set canopy goals with existing data sets, experts from Clark, WPI, Worcester State, and across the state that are working on understanding urban heat islands and the role of canopy and other climate change resiliency issues. She said her idea is to have it at the end of summer and to start planning as a Commission, putting together a list of people to reach out to and an agenda.

There was a brief discussion on this, on who to invite. Commissioner Elton made a motion to table this item. Second by Commissioner Wobbe. All were in favor. Motion was approved 4-0.
